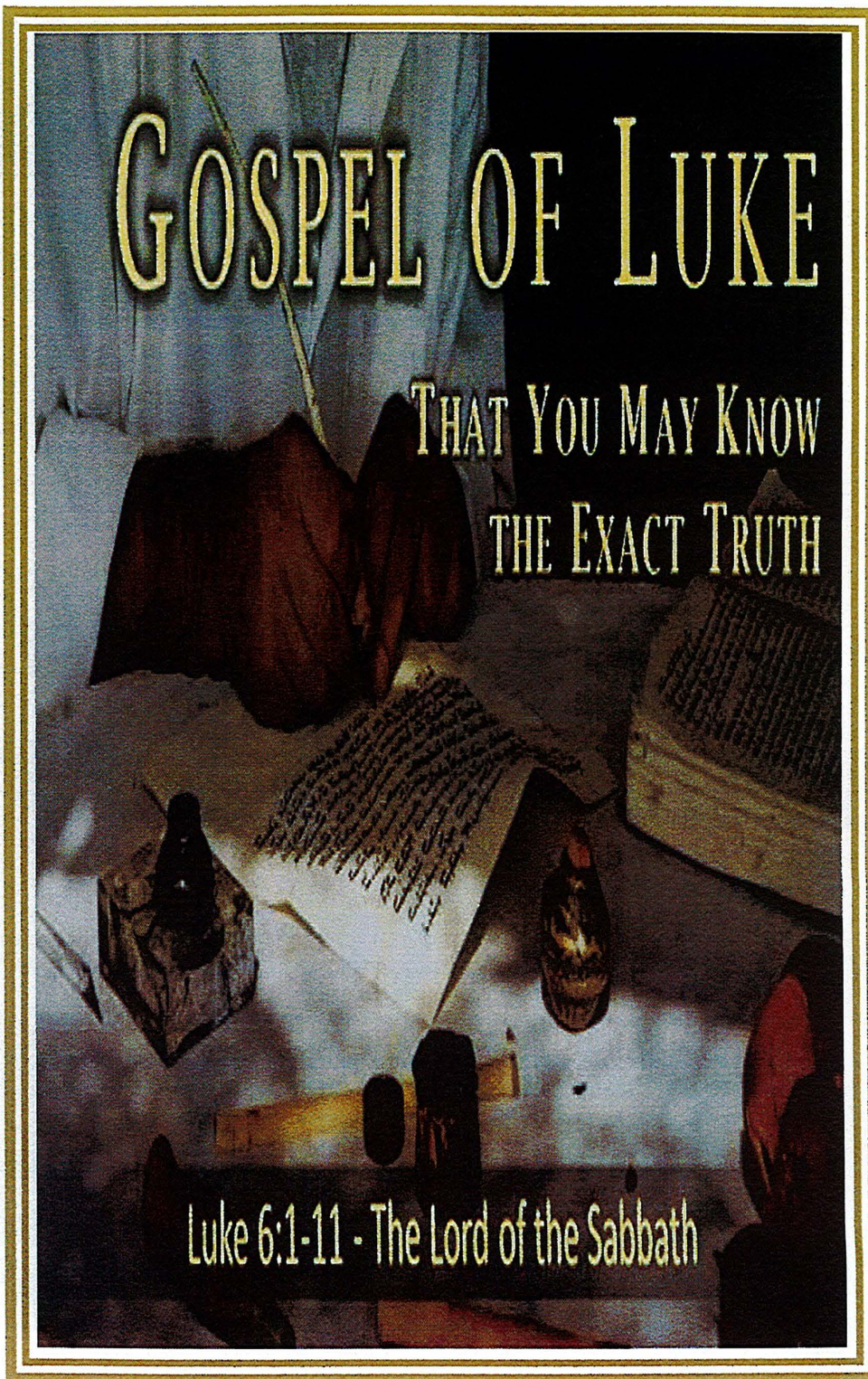
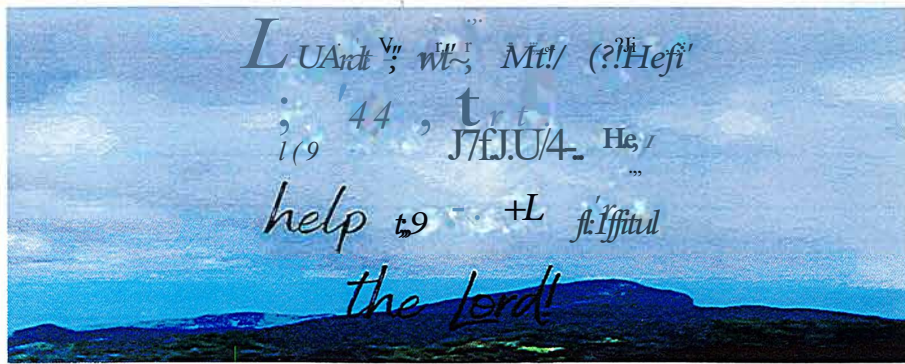

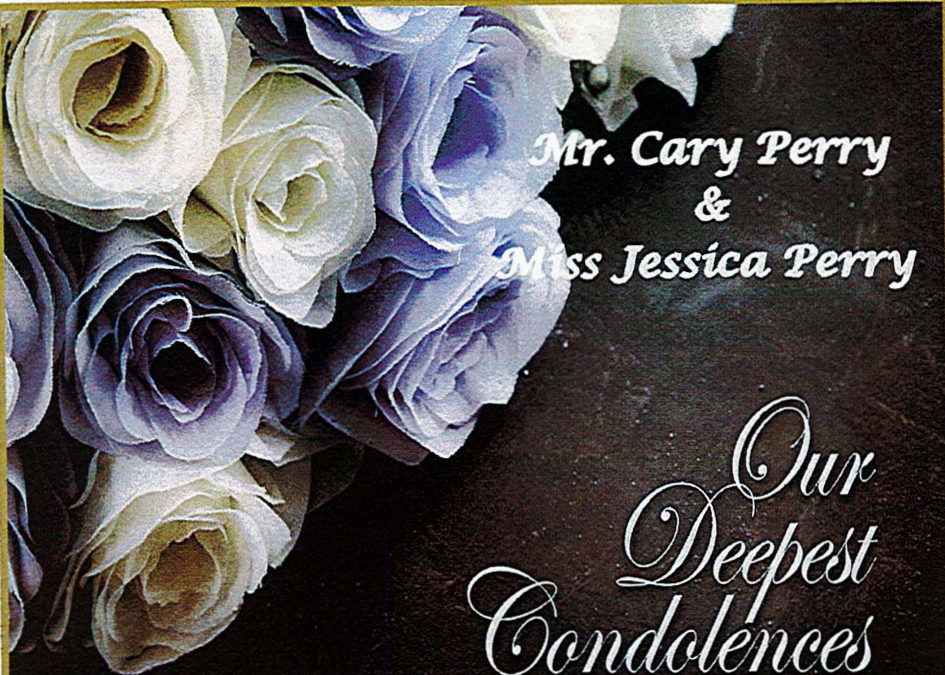

"Life is not fair, we only get what we are willing to fight for!" By praying for our men, boys and families we are positioned to "Fight to Win!" God used a man to redeem humanity and He continues to empower men to work in His Kingdom!

Heavenly Father, we thank You for our men in the Body of Christ. We thank You for equipping them to take their rightful place in You. Thank You for empowering them to walk in Your power and authority. Thank You for the men who will join the Body of Christ and glorify Your Name. 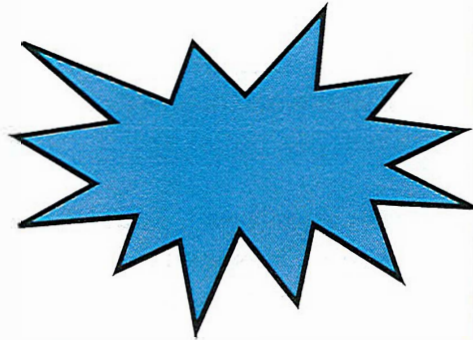

Revival is personal. I think one of the best definitions of it comes from Charles Finney, who said that revival "is the renewal of the first love of Cluistians, resulting in the awakening and conversion of sinners to God."

In the book of Revelation we find that Jesus commended the church of Ephesus for all the things it was doing right. This was an admirable church. It was a hardworking, discerning, faithful church. But despite their impressive track record, there was a problem with these believers, which Jesus pointed out

"Neoertheless I lume this ag11inst you, that you lu'De left your first WDe Remember therefore from where you havefallen; repent and do thefirst WO'tks" (Reoelttion 2:4-5 NKJV).

"You have left your first love," Jesus said. You don't love Me as you did at first. "When I lose something, I always retrace my steps. Where did I have it last? We can do the same with our first love. We need to go back to where we were before.

Notice that Jesus sai "You luive left yourfirst love" (emphasis mine). He didn't say, "You have lost your first love."

The good news is that it still can be found. God promises that if we pray and turn from our wicked ways and humble ourselv& , he will heal us. That applies to a broken family. That applies to a church. And that applies to a nation.


